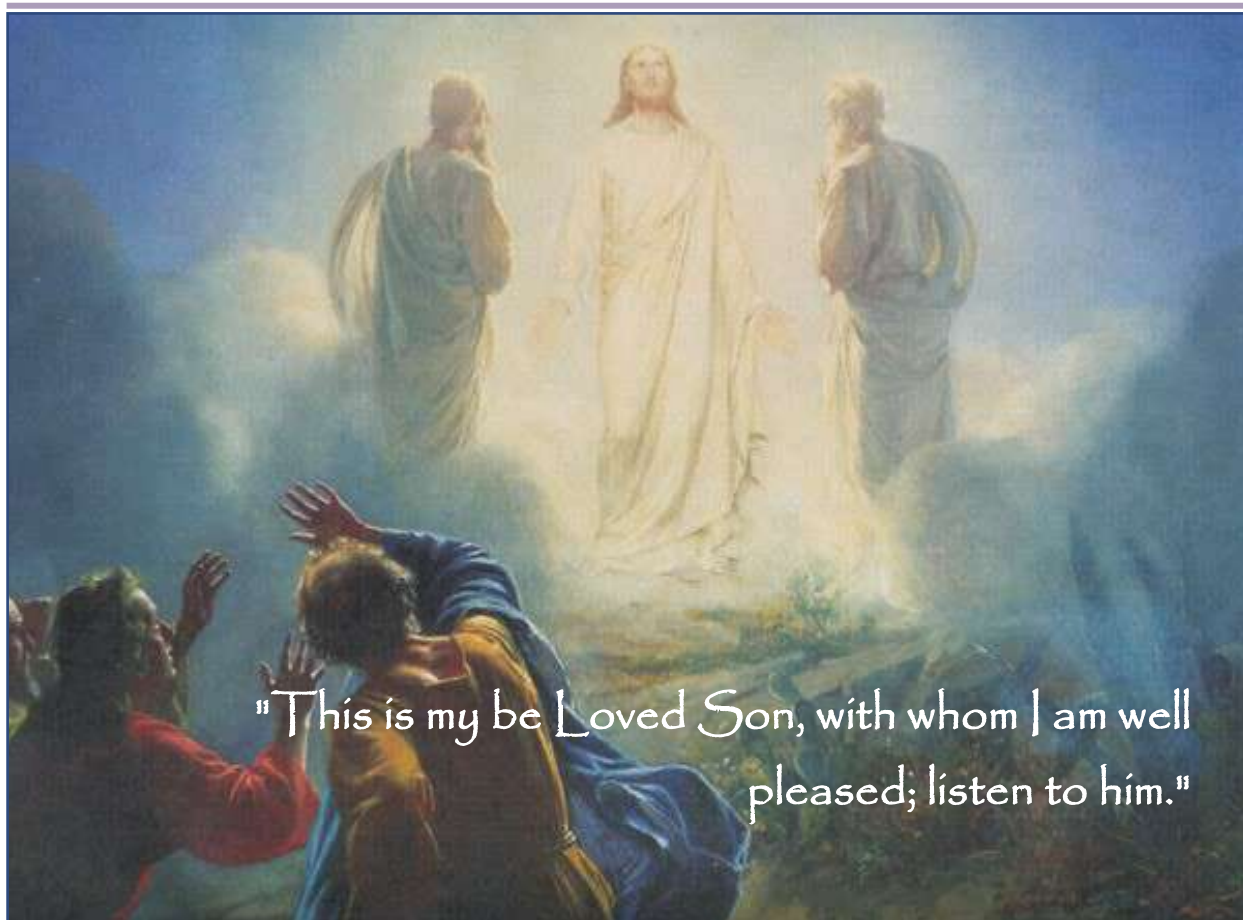




OLOA News

En aquel tiempo, Jesús tomó consigo a Pedro, a Santiago y a Juan, el hermano de éste, y los hizo subir a solas con él a un monte elevado. Ahí se transfiguró en su presencia: su rostro se puso resplandeciente como el sol y sus vestiduras se volvieron blancas como la nieve. De pronto aparecieron ante ellos Moisés y Elías, conversando con Jesús.

Entonces Pedro le dijo a Jesús: "Señor, ¡qué bueno sería quedarnos aquí! Si quieres, haremos aquí tres chozas, una para ti, otra para Moisés y otra para Elías".

Quando aún estaba hablando, una nube luminosa los cubrió y de ella salió una voz que decía: "Éste es mi Hijo muy amado, en quien tengo puestas mis complacencias; escúchenlo". Mt 7:1-9

Jesus took Peter, James, and his brother, John, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with him.

Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud cast a shadow over them, then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." When the disciples heard this, they fell prostrate and were very much afraid. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." And when the disciples raised their eyes, they saw no one else but Jesus alone.

As they were coming down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, "Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

Apreciados feligreses este Domingo la Santa Madre Iglesia, nos invita a vivir la Solemnidad de la Transfiguración del Señor. La pregunta que debemos hacernos es ¿Estás preparado para ver la gloria del Señor y compartir también en su gloria? ¡El Señor Jesús está ansioso por compartir su gloria con nosotros! Podemos echar un vistazo a esto cuando algunos de los discípulos ven a Jesús transfigurado en gloria en una alta montaña. Nuestro Señor a menudo fue a un lugar solitario para orar - para buscar la soledad y el santuario lejos de las multitudes. Pero en esta ocasión, el rostro de Jesús se puso radiante como el sol y su ropa se volvió deslumbrantemente blanca. Esta visión de luz y gloria radiante está prefigurada en la profecía de Daniel. En el capítulo 7 del Libro de Daniel en el Antiguo Testamento vemos una visión del "Hijo del Hombre que vino con las nubes del cielo" y fue presentado ante la corte real del cielo y el "Anciano de los Días" que está vestido Una vestidura radiante "blanca como la nieve" (Daniel 7: 9,13). El profeta Daniel predijo que Dios enviaría a su Ungido, el Hijo del Hombre, que vendría sobre las nubes del cielo para traer el reino de gloria y justicia de Dios sobre la tierra (véase Daniel 7: 13-15). La visión de Daniel describe una investidura real de un rey humano ante el trono de Dios. El Hijo del Hombre es un título mesiánico para el Rey ungido de Dios, el Señor Jesucristo. La palabra del Nuevo Testamento para "Mesías" es "Cristo", que literalmente significa el "Ungido" o el "Rey Ungido". Dios nos envió a su Hijo no para establecer un reino terrenal sino para llevarnos a su reino celestial, un reino gobernado por la verdad, la justicia, la paz y la santidad. El reino de Dios es el tema central de la misión de Jesús. Es el núcleo de su mensaje evangélico.

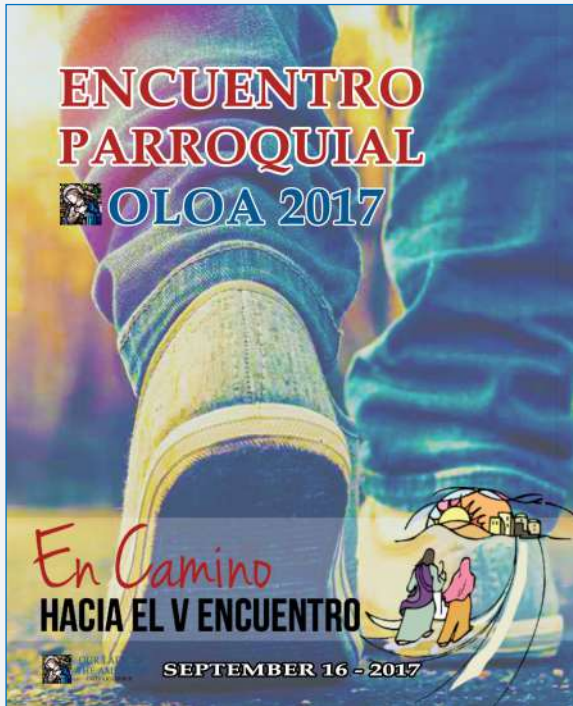
Dear parishioners, this Sunday the Holy Mother Church invites us to live the Solemnity of the Transfiguration of the Lord. The question we must ask ourselves is: Are you prepared to see the glory of the Lord and share in His glory? The Lord Jesus is eager to share His glory with us! We can see this when some of the disciples see Jesus transfigured in glory on a high mountain. Our Lord often went to a solitary place to pray - to seek solitude and sanctuary away from the crowds. But on this occasion, the face of Jesus became radiant as the sun and his clothes became dazzlingly white. This vision of radiant light and glory is prefigured in Daniel's prophecy. In chapter 7 of the Book of Daniel in the Old Testament we see a vision of "one like a son of man that came with the clouds of heaven", and was presented before the royal court of heaven and the "Ancient of Days" who is clothed a radiant garment "white as snow" (Daniel 7:9,13). The prophet Daniel predicted that God would send His anointed, the Son of Man, who would come upon the clouds of heaven to bring the kingdom of God's glory and righteousness upon the earth (see Daniel 7:13-15). Daniel's vision describes an actual endowment of a human king before the throne of God. The Son of Man is a Messianic title for the anointed King of God, the Lord Jesus Christ. The New Testament word for "Messiah" is "Christ," which literally means "Anointed One" or "Anointed King." God sent us His Son not to establish an earthly kingdom but to lead us to His heavenly kingdom, a kingdom governed by truth, justice, peace and holiness. The kingdom of God is the central theme of Jesus' mission. It is the core of his evangelical message.

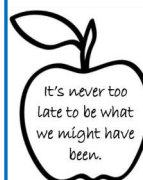

I did not quite know why at the time, but I had a lot of shame from the way I lived my life. It seemed like every morning I would wake up terribly regretting my choices from the day before — even though they were the choices that I believed would lead me to happiness. Furthermore, I put these choices before my relationships with others and began to feel increasingly isolated and alone.

I finally came to realize God's plan for me. However, I had to stop grasping at everything the world was trying to offer me, in order to be open to receive everything God wanted to give me. Furthermore, for God, I gave up what I thought I could never live without. At the age of 21, when most people start, I gave up drinking.

It's crazy to say this now, but I really cannot stop peaking! Everyday my life is a vibrant experience of joy and I owe it all to God.

The world lied to me and told me that it would only be through money, pleasure, and doing whatever I wanted when I wanted that would make me happy. However, I learned instead that, by sacrificing these things — everything the world wants to offer — in favor of a life lived in relationship with Christ that true happiness is found.
